

## **Galway Preserve Letterbox;**

### ***Cooking up a Surprise***

Park at the Education building. Take a deep breath and see if you can smell where the water is. This is your direction of travel.

If the water is not drawing you in through smell then you should follow the yellow brick road starting to the northeast of the building.

Keep the water to your immediate east as the trail wraps north/northwest. The evergreen plantation will be on your immediate west. Can you tell this is a plantation? How?

From the yellow brick road you will see a red carpet rolled out for you. Take the red carpet, descending with the water still to your immediate east. If you are on the correct path you will see several grape vines hanging in the trees on your right.

The red carpet will meet up with the yellow brick road again. At this juncture turn about 38 degrees northeast (a hard right over the bridge).

Quickly turn southeast about 110 degrees (another hard right) to get on the blue velvet path. You will pass over the creek again. What is this creek? Where is its source?

You will split the two ponds now – walking in between them on a land bridge.

At the next fork in the trail you can go right or left. Choose northeast.

If you're on the correct path now, there will be an old warming hut building just off the trail. Walk past the warming hut.

About 40 paces after the warming hut STOP.  
Look all around for something you could bake a loaf of bread in.  
Go there.

When you are there, you almost got it. Do you see it?

Heat rises and so do surprises.  
That's your last clue.
