Potential Eagle Scout Project List for 2011-2012

Galway Preserve, Galway, (50 acres, 1.5 miles of trail)

- Signs: Install interpretive plaques with environmental and historical information
- Building demolition: Take down and remove swim shed and outhouse, as they have become a hazard.
- Table construction: Build a picnic table and benches that can be secured for placement under tree near Education building. Could have a small roof over it if desired for project.

Hennig Preserve, Providence NY, (604 acres opening in 2011, 5+ miles of trail)

- Bridge installation: Build one small and one larger bog bridge (no cement is to be used).
- Rustic benches: 5 trailside benches needed. We prefer a rustic look. Design, build and install.
- Rock steps: Break through old rock wall and build stone staircase
- Signs: Install interpretive plaques with environmental and historical information

Woodcock Preserve, Clifton Park, (75 acres, 1 mile of trail)

- Design and install Kiosk with registration box
- Rustic benches: Design and install 3 benches
- Erect barriers: Build 3 barriers to keep ATV's out of nature preserve

Levine Preserve, Providence (73 acres, ½ mile of trail)

- Trails: Plan, design and install 2 miles of new trails.
