

Spring Run Trail Letterbox Clues

Whether you're walking, running, biking, or skipping, start your journey at the corner of East Side & Excelsior where the sign marks the trailhead

Start your adventure on this paved path following the fence of your left; continue until you reach a pond with a stump in the center. Do you spot any wildlife? Or the letterbox...You may spot a few birds, but you won't find your letterbox here.

Carry on in the direction that the water is flowing, keep an eye and ear on the water as you go, as it might disappear out of sight from the path every so often; the water will sure point you in the right direction to find what you are looking for!

If you are still on the right track, as you travel on you should pass over a bridge. If it is spring, summer, or fall take a look at the lettuce like plant on the sides of the path, this is skunk cabbage...do you think it would smell good?

This journey will take you over another smaller bridge and then under an overpass (there is an entrance leading onto the path right after the overpass, so if you are joining us from there then you should start listening to clues now)

Hear the water? Cross over the running water

Go in between the two old stone walls and continue

The water should be parallel to your path again. If you're lucky you might spot a deer or two, or even a fox while on your journey...maybe they'll be able to help you find the letterbox?

Keep going and you should pass through a large opening of a field of cattails along with other vegetation which should lead you under another overpass

A little bit after you pass the section of path with a wooden fence on the left, can you spot an unusual tree duo on your right? Look for two trees approximately 40 feet from the path, up on a bank. The two tree trunks are combined together, a white pine and a white oak. Cool huh? Yet, still no letterbox there.

Keep going and enjoy the scenery.

If you spot and hear a lot of cars you have reached the end! But to find what you are looking for, you must go back from where you once began!

As you head back keep your eyes peeled for two tall pine trees that stand directly after the section of path with wooding fencing (now on your right)

Go and check out the trees interesting bark and look around their roots, the larger of the two pines is shading the letterbox you desire!
