

Tanner Road Letterbox

Enter the preserve near the parking area, begin by walking along the trail.

Walk along the shady trail keeping your eyes on the ground, if you are going in the right direction you will come to a spot where many large roots cross the trail. Walk over these roots and continue.

Still in the shade, you will come to what looks to be a dried up streambed crossing the trail. Step over this also, and continue on, you are on the right path.

Soon, you will see a field ahead, walk towards this field. As you follow the trail through the field keep an eye out for a large boulder pile on the right side of the trail. Watch out for poison ivy in this area! With this pile on your right, and wetlands to your left keep going.

The shade will begin to return and you should walk over a rock path. The ground can get moist around here.

Pass a pile of large rocks on your left and continue forward under two bent trees on either side of the trail. Just after these trees, look to the drier side of the trail, in a place that won't easily be flooded, and you will find what you've been searching for.
